IMPORTANT NOTE: The intention of this course being offered at the 8th grade level is to provide students with a rigorous curriculum that will ensure that they challenge themselves and require them to review and study DAILY. It should be made clear that <u>the grade the</u> <u>student receives for this course WILL carry on to most high schools</u>. Thus, if the student does not receive a satisfactory score (B or higher) for this course at the end of the year, it is highly advisable that the student retakes Algebra in high school so that their high school GPA will not reflect the grade they received.
